- Materials: Ensure access to a variety of art materials like colored pencils, crayons, paints, paper, scissors, glue, etc.
- Creativity: Encourage students to express their own ideas and interpretations in their artwork.

Class 4 Syllabus – Art & Design

#### Term 1

#### 1.Patterns in Nature

- Task: Observe and draw patterns found in plants and animals in a local park or garden in Delhi.
- Examples:
- Draw the veins of a peepal leaf (common in Delhi).
- Create a pattern based on the scales of a fish from the Yamuna River.
- Draw the repeating pattern on the wings of a butterfly seen in Lodhi Gardens.

#### 2.Patterns on Fabric

- Task: Collect different fabric scraps or observe clothing with various patterns. Create a design inspired by one of them.
- Examples:
- Draw a design inspired by the floral patterns on a Rajasthani lehenga.
- Create a repeating pattern based on the geometric designs of a handloom shawl.
- Design a border pattern inspired by the motifs on a printed cotton kurta.

#### 3.Borders and Corners

- Task: Design decorative borders and corner motifs using geometric shapes and patterns.
- Examples:
- Create a border for a drawing using repeating triangles and circles.
- Design a corner motif for a greeting card using traditional Indian paisley designs.
- Make a border for a page using patterns inspired by the arches of Qutub Minar.

#### 4. Primary and Secondary Colors

- Task: Mix primary colors (red, yellow, blue) to create secondary colors (orange, green, purple). Paint a picture using only these six colors.
- Examples:
- Paint a sunset over the Yamuna River using shades of orange and purple.
- Create a still life of fruits and vegetables using only primary and secondary colors.
- Paint a picture of a peacock using the vibrant secondary colors.

### 5. Fun with Secondary Colors

- Task: Create artwork using only secondary colors.
- Examples:
- Paint a landscape of Delhi during monsoon season using shades of green and purple.
- Design an abstract pattern using only orange, green, and purple.
- Create a collage of paper cutouts in secondary colors.

#### 6.Tints, Tones, and Shades

- Task: Explore how to lighten and darken colors using white, black, and grey. Paint a picture using different tints, tones, and shades of a single color.
- Examples:
- Paint a series of lotus flowers in different shades of pink.
- Create a landscape of the Red Fort using different tones of brown and grey.
- Paint a still life of a metal object using different shades of grey.

#### 7.Let's Take a Break (Collage)

- Task: Create a collage using various materials (paper, fabric, leaves, etc.) to depict a scene from Delhi life.
- Examples:
- Make a collage of a busy market scene in Chandni Chowk.
- Create a collage of a park in Delhi with children playing.
- Design a collage depicting the historical monuments of Delhi.

#### 8.Pencil Shading

- Task: Practice different pencil shading techniques (hatching, cross-hatching, blending) to create depth and form.
- Examples:
- Draw a sphere and shade it to make it look three-dimensional.
- Draw a simple still life of a fruit and shade it to show its texture.
- Draw a portrait of a face and shade it to create highlights and shadows.

#### 9. Sketchpen Rendering

- Task: Explore the use of sketch pens for line work and rendering.
- Examples:
- Draw a detailed sketch of a building in Connaught Place using sketch pens.
- Create a line drawing of a tree in a park using different line thicknesses.
- Draw a portrait using cross-hatching and stippling techniques with sketch pens.

#### 10.Composition (Independence Day) – Step by Step Tutorial
